## Trees:

We are waiting for our planning application to be decided. We have asked for up to a 25% reduction in the height of the trees and to remove all deadwood at the same time. As soon as we hear from Wiltshire Council we will undertake the work. The Path may have to be closed for the hours when work is taken place. We will do our best to work within school times.

Some may have seen incorrect information about the closure of the path, we received the following email from Wiltshire Council;

"As we discussed, there was confusion on our part over when the initial safety works were planned to take place; by the time the request for a temporary closure order for the public footpath reached the Rights of Way warden, he thought that because they were emergency works they would have already been done. Unfortunately, this wasn't checked and no order was made. I can only apologize for the difficulties this has caused"
